VENDOR'S TERMS AND AGREEMENTS

1. Food vendors are advised to use a mobile and/or food truck set up for their service. Provide your own generators as there is no power source to share.
2. Food vendors will be required to provide their own utensils, plates, napkins, etc.
3. Vendors are granted the privilege to sell merchandise within a 10 ft. X 10 ft. space ONLY. You must provide your own canopy, tables and chairs. Spaces will be on pavement.
4. No sales of Pepsi products are allowed on Cheney Stadium premises.
5. Vendors will provide a copy of the Department of Health Food License for Pierce County.
6. Vendor will provide a copy of insurance coverage per individual carrier.
7. Food vendors will provide a copy of food handlers permits
8. Vendors will provide own internet connection for card sales.
9. Vendors are responsible for their own cash sales, garbage, set up, and tear down.
10. Vendors' set-up is on Monday, September 2nd, starting at 8:30 am – you will be coordinating directly with event planner, Carissa Birge
11. Donate a door prize (optional). Donations are good for advertising your business.
12. Additional display items are allowed within your space.
13. **First come...First serve on vendor space.**
14. Weather Conditions: **REFUNDS WILL NOT** be issued because of inclement weather. The event will **PROCEED** regardless of weather conditions.
15. Vendors and participants will release the Event organizers and affiliates of **ANY** and **ALL** liability and claims that may arise from **ANY** injuries, damages or losses suffered or incurred by you or to your property in connection with this event.
16. Failure to comply with the above rules is considered a breach of contract agreement and shall result in the termination of this contract, removal from the premises and forfeiture of deposit and / or event participation monies.
17. I agree that I have read **ALL** the rules and regulations and fully understand and agree with the guidelines. I accept full financial responsibility for any damages done on my part, my associates and my booth area. I will be professional, respectable and conduct good business to the customers and associate vendors according to these regulations. I indemnify and hold harmless Black Dollar Day Task Force and Event Associates against **ALL** claims for personal injuries, death, merchandise and personal damages, cost and expenses including attorney fees caused by or against myself, event organizers and businesses.
